An Environmental Health Professional is a specialist in the control of the environment for better health; an advocate and applier of practices to control hazardous elements in the environment; an organizer of economic and social forces to provide and maintain a safe and healthy environment for the betterment of all human beings.

Gerald Story Memorial Award (1990)

To be awarded to an active member in good standing of UEHA who has served in the environmental health profession for two to five years. The recipient will receive a cash award \$100.

Required Criteria:

- * Currently employed as an environmental health professional.
- * Personifies the standards of UEHA By-Laws.

Other achievements that may be considered: (Helpful but not required)

- * Demonstrated activity to advance UEHA.
- * Involvement with UEHA board committee(s) or special assignments.
- * Submission of articles to UEHA Newsletter or other public health publications.
- * Special accomplishments or projects in environmental health.

Reed Roberts Memorial Award (1998)

To be awarded to an active member in good standing of UEHA who has served in the environmental health profession for more than five years. The recipient will receive a cash award \$150.

Required Criteria:

- * Currently employed as an environmental health professional.
- * Personifies the standards of UEHA By-Laws.

Other achievements that may be considered: (Helpful but not required)

- * Demonstrated activity to advance UEHA.
- * Has served as UEHA officer, committee or special assignments.
- * Submission of articles to UEHA Newsletter or other public health publications.
- * Special accomplishments or projects in environmental health.

Pickett-Webb Memorial Award (1954)

To be awarded to an active member in good standing of UEHA for outstanding career achievement in environmental health for 12 or more years. The recipient will receive a cash award of \$200.

Required Criteria:

- * Currently employed as an environmental health professional.
- * Personifies the standards of UEHA By-Laws.
- * Involved directly as a board or committee member, or has made significant contribution(s) to the Association.

Other achievements that may be considered: (Helpful but not required)

- * Other public health or environmental health activities and memberships.
- * Broadness and strength of the program(s) in which the candidate is involved.
- * Individual accomplishments, special activities, accomplishments above and beyond usual employment.
- * Authored or co-authored articles in public health publications.
- * Education and special courses of training.
- * Extracurricular activities and achievements.

Lynn Thatcher Award

This award has been established to honor someone outside the Association who has made a significant contribution to the field of Environmental Health.
